Dear Council Members,

I am writing to request a permit to have 6 female chickens in a backyard coop at 2601 Saint Anthony Blvd in Saint Anthony. Attached is a drawing of my property including details of the backyard and current location of the coop and run.

The raised chicken coop has dimensions of approximately 6.25' L x 5.5' W x 6' H and is made out of a wood composite to promote climate control throughout the seasons. The run, which is made out of cedar and chicken wire, is connected to the coop and has dimensions of approximately 11.5' L x 4' W x 5' H and also goes under the dimensions of the coop for additional space. The coop and run are completely covered/enclosed by a privacy fence which is built around the entire backyard.

I was notified by the city that I needed to submit a permit for the coop and chickens. My utmost and sincerest apologies for not knowing this needed to be done prior to having them. Before I built the coop, I did however communicate to my immediate neighbors my plan to raise hens for eggs and no one had any issue, in fact they were actually excited and several of the neighborhood kids stop by to visit them. I clean everything out weekly and have an organic deodorizer I use to keep any potential smell and flies at bay. I have encouraged them if they have any issues at any time to let me know, as I am open to any concerns and feedback they may have.
