



Silver Lake Road Flood Reduction Project Project and Appurtenant Work Construction Update #7

Current Events

The Contractor has completed construction at the retaining wall and continued the installation of storm sewer along the east side of Silver Lake Road north of Silver Lane.

Future Events

Contractor will continue to install storm sewer along the east side of Silver Lake Road next week, week of June 10th. It is anticipated that the intersection of Silver Lane will be closed to traffic beginning Monday, June 10th to allow for the storm sewer installation, ***weather permitting***.

Lane Closures – current through mid-July 2019

Silver Lake Road will allow two-way traffic, with left turn restrictions at Silver Lane, for the duration of the project. To accommodate construction operations, lane shifts are anticipated.

Periodic updates to traffic impacts will be provided throughout the project as they become available.

- Stay alert! Watch for signs, equipment, and workers
- Please remind children to stay away from the construction site, equipment, and stockpiles of materials.
