



## Silver Lake Road Flood Reduction Project Project and Appurtenant Work Construction Update #13

### Current Events

Ramsey County has completed their curb removal and replacement on Silver Lake Road near Silver Lane this week, week of July 12<sup>th</sup>, in anticipation for their mill and overlay project scheduled for the end of August.

### Future Events

The Contractor will complete the remaining sidewalk patching next week, week of July 22<sup>nd</sup>, with temporary roadway striping to follow. Once the sidewalk patch and roadway striping has been completed, the signal at Silver Lake Road and Silver Lane will return to normal operation.

**PLEASE NOTE: the pavement will remain low in anticipation for the Ramsey County mill and overlay improvement along Silver Lake Road scheduled for late August. A wedge has been installed along all sides of the patch to accommodate traffic in the interim.**

- Please remind children to stay away from the construction site, equipment, and stockpiles of materials.
