Project Schedule

As previously indicated, the project is to be completed in phases to allow access to properties as feasible:

Phase 1: MacAlaster Drive

Phase 2: Foss Road

Phase 3: Highcrest Road

Phase 1: The Contractor has not yet begun construction operations along MacAlaster Drive. Additional information will be provided once the Contractor schedules this work.

Phase 2: The Contractor has completed utility work on the north end of Foss Road and has begun building the roadway section. Once the roadway has been constructed to class 5, the Contractor will continue south on Foss Road with removing the pavement and installing utilities.

Phase 3: The Contractor has completed sanitary sewer installation along Highcrest Road and will continue with watermain and storm sewer installation throughout the week. Following storm sewer installation, the Contractor will begin building the roadway section. Additional information will be provided once the roadway has been constructed to a drivable surface and the temporary roadway is removed.

The above schedule is tentative and subject to change due to weather or scheduling conflicts.
