



Volunteer Opportunity

The St. Anthony Police Department is seeking to fill vacant Police Reserve Officer positions. This is a volunteer position that is suitable for law enforcement students looking for professional experience or community members who simply want a fun and exciting way to give back. Some of the duties of a St. Anthony Police Reserve Officer are as follows:

- Patrolling city parks on foot and in a squad car
- Parking enforcement
- Traffic control
- Courtesy transports and transports of arrestees to both Hennepin and Ramsey County jails at the direction of a licensed police officer
- Providing a presence and representing the police department at community events throughout the year
- Other calls for police service that do not require the attention of a police officer
- Assisting police officers in various other duties as requested

As a Police Reserve Officer you will have access to in-house department training and the opportunity to attend the Hennepin County Reserve Officer School. You will also be trained in radio communications in Hennepin and Ramsey Counties, use-of-force, traffic direction, and our Computer Assisted Dispatch (CAD) system. Most importantly, you will gain valuable professional experience and professional contacts to assist in becoming a police officer in the future.

The successful Reserve Candidate will meet the following requirements:

- Be at least 21 years of age (18 years of age considered if enrolled in a law enforcement program)
- Complete a City of St. Anthony Application (available at our website)
- Successfully complete an oral board examination and background checks
- Pass Field Training requirements in a timely fashion
- Work a minimum of 150 hours per year and be available to work 1-2 Friday or Saturday night shifts per month
- Be available to work 3 mandatory community events per year
