Request: Community Survey Results

BACKGROUND

The City of St. Anthony conducted The National Community Survey (NCS) August 1, 2022 through September 19, 2022. The NCS evaluates the “livability” of St. Anthony. The phrase “livable community” is used to describe a place that is not simply habitable, but that is desirable. Great communities include partnerships between government, private sector, community organizations, and residents. The NCS captures residents’ opinions on the following ten facets of community:

- Economy
- Mobility
- Community Design
- Utilities
- Safety
- Natural Environment
- Parks and Recreation
- Health and Wellness
- Education, Arts and Culture
- Inclusivity and Engagement

Based on the questions asked, both council and staff can use the results for strategic planning, operations planning and evaluation of comparisons to other cities to gauge how St. Anthony compares to other local or national communities in determining trends.
