### Current Events

The Contractor has completed the replacement of the deficient concrete within Silver Point Park.

### Future Events

The Contractor is anticipated to complete the remaining improvements of the basketball court, trail, and parking lot within Silver Point Park on Monday, September 23<sup>rd</sup>, weather permitting.

The Contractor is anticipated to begin removal and replacement of deficient sidewalk within Salo Park beginning Monday, September 23 and continuing throughout the week.

### Caring for Your Newly Seeded Lawn

Please refrain from mowing your lawn shorter than 3.5-inches for at least one year following seed placement and continue to water your lawn at least 2-inches of water a week, especially during the months of June, July, and August.

### Lawn Irrigation

If you have a lawn irrigation system or pet fence within the City right-of-way and curb was replaced adjacent to your property, please check to see that your system is working properly. If your system was damaged due to the construction project, please contact Kate at the number below to schedule a time to have your system repaired.

### Tips of the Week

Please don't hesitate to water your lawn if it is a hot day and you notice the seedbed is dry. Any additional watering you can provide will only result in a healthier thicker lawn.
