### Current Events

City staff have been meeting with residents throughout the week regarding the results of the individual sanitary sewer service televising reports. Although the repairs are optional and the responsibility of the homeowners, staff will continue to coordinate with residents to resolve private sanitary sewer service deficiencies to help reduce flows being treated by the MCES. Additionally, staff has met onsite with individual property owners regarding impacts to landscaping, trees, private irrigation, etc.

### Future Events

A preconstruction meeting with the Contractor will be held the week of March 20<sup>th</sup> to discuss the anticipated proposed schedule and project phasing. Following the meeting, notification will be mailed to residents regarding construction and the project schedule.
