Construction Is About To Begin

The contract for construction for the 2017 37th Avenue Sidewalk & Signal Project was awarded to Sunram Construction, Inc.

Trees and Shrubs

The onsite project representative will be marking trees and shrubs scheduled for removal within the project corridor by Friday, May 19, 2017. Trees and shrubs scheduled for removal will be marked with a bright colored ribbon. If you have questions or concerns about these items please contact Ben Perkey immediately. Removal of these items is anticipated to begin the week of May 22, 2017, weather permitting.

Landscaping and Irrigation Systems

If your property has a below ground irrigation system, please have the sprinkler head locations marked by Monday, May 22nd.

Landscaping items within the City right-of-way may need to be removed for construction purposes. If there are any items such as flowers, plants, rock gardens, etc. within the right-of-way you would like to save and reinstall yourself; please do so by Monday, May 22nd.

Resident Notes

Construction operations may generate dust, noise, and inconveniences. We appreciate your patience and understanding. Vibrations may be generated throughout the construction process. We suggest that valuables that may fall from shelves or walls during construction, be removed and stored somewhere safe.

Driveway access may be disturbed temporarily during the process. The project team will do their best to minimize this disturbance and provide as much notification to residents as possible.

Mail delivery and garbage pickup will not be affected by the construction process. If you have deliveries scheduled to your home, please provide notice to the onsite project representative.

Please be aware of construction signage and cones throughout the construction process. The Contractor plans to use a posted traffic lane shift as necessary to allow room for work to be done.

Construction Schedule

The construction schedule is tentative and is subject to change due to weather or scheduling conflicts.

During the week of May 22, the Contractor plans to pothole existing utilities to verify location and depth below the surface. Also during this week, the contractor will be removing all trees necessary to complete the work.

The Contractor plans to begin work at Stinson Boulevard and 37th Avenue and work their way from west to east through the project corridor.

Tips of the Week

- Stay alert! Be aware of signs, lane shifts, construction equipment and workers.
- Please have irrigation systems marked before construction begins.
- Please remove any landscaping items you would like to save before construction begins.
- Please remind children to stay away from the construction site, equipment, and stockpiles of materials.
