



2017 37th Avenue Sidewalk & Signal Project Construction Update #10

Current Events

All retaining walls of the project have been completed.

The Contractor's grading crew has been grading yards to an acceptable slope that will meet sidewalk grade.

Egan Electric has begun signal work at 39th Avenue and Stinson Boulevard. Please be aware that this intersection is temporarily an All Way Stop while work is being conducted.

Future Events

Week of July 31st (Weather Permitting)

The sub-contractor will continue signal and pedestrian crossing improvements at Stinson Boulevard and 39th Avenue as well as Stinson Boulevard and 37th Avenue.

It is anticipated that the concrete sub-contractor will be back on site to continue work along 37th Avenue.

The Contractor will continue any necessary turf grading operations between Stinson Boulevard and Highcrest Road. This crew will also begin to remove pavement at the intersection of Highcrest Road and 37th Avenue.
