



2017 37th Avenue Sidewalk & Signal Project Construction Update #18

Current Events

The sodding subcontractor has installed sod along 37th Avenue. It is the contractor's responsibility to water the sod for 30 days following placement. After 30 days it is the homeowner's responsibility to water the sod. Please do not mow sod for 30 days until the root systems have begun to take.

The traffic control subcontractor has removed cones and barricades from the south side of 37th Avenue and relocated them to the necessary locations at the intersections of 37th Avenue and Highcrest Road, 37th Avenue and Silver Lake Road, Silver Lake Road and 39th Avenue, and Silver Lake Road and Silver Lane.

This subcontractor has also reinstalled signs along 37th Avenue.

Future Events

Week of September 25th (Weather Permitting)

It is anticipated the Contractor will begin to remove pavement at the above listed intersections where traffic control barricades are in place.

Following removals, some signals will be out of service and relocated. Be prepared for intersections to be temporarily signed as four-way stops.

- Please be safe when traveling along 37th Avenue and Silver Lake Road. The traffic control is in place for safety of the Contractor as well as protection of you and your vehicle.
