Concrete installation has been completed for the project.

This week the paving subcontractor completed the asphalt patching along Silver Lake Road.

The Contractor will be finishing grading and turf establishment operations this week.

Permanent traffic control has been removed from the roadway; however, the Contractor is using temporary traffic control measures to work at specific intersections. Please stay aware of these temporary closures and lane shifts.

The electrical subcontractor will be onsite Friday to begin pedestrian push button installation.
