



## 2018 Street and Utility Improvement Project and Appurtenant Work Construction Update #3

### Current Events

Center Point Energy has been actively working to relocate gas main within the project corridor.

Reliable Tree Service has been removing trees throughout the project corridor and is anticipated to be completed by Friday, June 8<sup>th</sup>.

Kuechle Underground plans to begin pavement removals on Foss Road on Monday, June 11<sup>th</sup>. **If you are a resident or property owner north of 3737 and 3800 Foss Road please plan to have vehicles out of your driveway and parked somewhere safe by 7:00 AM each day.**

### Future Events

After pavement removals, during the week of June 11<sup>th</sup>, Kuechle Underground will begin pipe laying operations. First system addressed will be the removal of sanitary sewer and new sewer installation.

In preparations for water main installation, a temporary water system will be placed to provide service to properties. Residents, property owners and/or managers please be aware that the Contractor will need to conduct work within your building to ensure water is being provided from the temporary system.

Pavement removals for Highcrest Road are currently scheduled for the week of June 18<sup>th</sup>.

*The above schedule is tentative and is subject to change due to weather or scheduling conflicts.*

### Tips of the Week

- Construction hours begin at 7:00AM and we ask that any vehicle you may need for the day is parked in a safe place prior to the start of operations each day.
- Please observe posted detour and warning signs.
- Please do not park vehicles on streets under construction, especially if pavement has been removed.
- Slow down and watch for uneven surfaces.
- Stay alert! Watch for signs, equipment, and workers
- Please remind children to stay away from the construction site, equipment, and stockpiles of materials.
- Access through the site may change throughout the day as construction progresses; your patience is appreciated.
