Construction Update #33 – 7/3/2019

Current Events

The Contractor has completed the majority of driveway restoration and begun irrigation system repair this week, week of July 1st. The Contractor has been unable to continue boulevard restoration this week due to unfavorable weather conditions earlier in the week.

Future Events

The Contractor is anticipated to continue boulevard restoration and begin tree replacement installation along Macalaster Drive, Foss Road, and Highcrest Road the week of July 8th, *weather permitting*.

Final paving along Macalaster Drive, Foss Road, and Highcrest Road is anticipated to be completed late next week, *weather permitting*.

The above schedule is tentative and is subject to change due to weather or scheduling conflicts.

There will be NO construction activity on Macalaster Drive, Foss Road, and Highcrest Road on Thursday, July 4th, in observance of the Independence Day holiday.

Tips of the Week

- Please be patient with the Contractor as the remaining work behind the curb is being completed. The trucks necessary for hauling material may cause delays on the roadway.
- Please observe posted detour and warning signs.
- Please do not park vehicles on streets under construction.
- Slow down and watch for uneven surfaces.
- Stay alert! Watch for signs, equipment, and workers
- As grading operations continue please keep a safe distance from stockpiles and equipment, watch for workers as you drive through the site, and obey all traffic control.
- Please remind children to stay away from the construction site, equipment, and stockpiles of materials.
- Access through the site may change throughout the day as construction progresses; your patience is appreciated.
