The Contractor has completed remaining boulevard seeding, tree installation, driveway repairs, and final asphalt paving this week, week of July 22nd.

Future Events

The Contractor is anticipated to complete remaining irrigation system repairs and mailbox relocations next week, week of July 29th. The onsite project representative, Bo Schuette, will be preparing a list of remaining project items to be completed ("punch list") in the next week. The Contractor will continue to address turf establishment repairs and project clean up over the next several weeks in addition to addressing punch list items.

The above schedule is tentative and is subject to change due to weather or scheduling conflicts.
