



2024 Street Improvement Project Construction Update # 2

Current Events

Due to the inclement weather, the Contractor has rescheduled removal and replacement of deficient concrete curb for the week following the 4th of July holiday (week of July 8th). In preparation for removal of the deficient curb, the Contractor has begun sawing the concrete panels on Friday, June 21st.

Future Events

The Contractor is anticipated to complete the minor storm sewer work on 34th Avenue next week, week of June 24th, weather permitting. A more detailed phasing plan of where the Contractor will begin and end will be available once received from the Contractor.

Please note: The roadways will remain open to traffic throughout the project; however, parking along the roadway will be restricted to allow for the replacement of curb.

The above schedule is tentative and is subject to change due to weather or scheduling conflicts.

Lawn Irrigation and Pet Fences

If you have a lawn irrigation system or pet fence within the City right-of-way, please mark the location of the sprinkler heads before construction. This will allow the contractor to take precautionary measures to protect your irrigation system and pet fence or identify where to replace the system if it cannot be avoided.

Tips of the Week

- Please observe posted detour and warning signs.
- Slow down and watch for uneven surfaces.
- Stay alert! Watch for signs, equipment, and workers.
- Please remind children to stay away from the construction site, equipment, and stockpiles of materials.
- Access through the site may change throughout the day as construction progresses; your patience is appreciated.
