Current Events

The Contractor has completed restoration and seeding behind replaced curb areas.

Future Events

The Contractor is anticipated to complete the removal of deficient sidewalk panels within Salo Park the week of September 9th.

The Contractor is anticipated to complete the removal of deficient sidewalk panels and begin trail improvements within Silver Point Park to begin the week of September 9th, weather permitting. The basketball court and parking lot improvements within Silver Point Park to be completed following the sidewalk and trail improvements.

The above schedule is tentative and is subject to change due to weather or scheduling conflicts.

Caring for Your Newly Seeded Lawn

Please refrain from mowing your lawn shorter than 3.5-inches for at least one year following seed placement and continue to water your lawn at least 2-inches of water a week, especially during the months of June, July, and August.

Lawn Irrigation

If you have a lawn irrigation system or pet fence within the City right-of-way and curb was replaced adjacent to your property, please check to see that your system is working properly. If your system was damaged due to the construction project, please contact Kate at the number below to schedule a time to have your system repaired.

Tips of the Week

- Please don't hesitate to water your lawn if it is a hot day and you notice the seedbed is dry. Any additional watering you can provide will only result in a healthier thicker lawn.
