

Earlier this week, the City of Columbia Heights began the rehabilitation of their sanitary sewer main along Stinson Blvd. Columbia Heights' contractor, Visu-Sewer, Inc., anticipates the rehabilitation work to last through the week of April 11.

Weather permitting, RL Larson Excavating, Inc., will begin installing traffic control later this week and anticipates to begin removing topsoil and pavement early next week in the area north of 39<sup>th</sup> Avenue and south of Silver Lane. Stinson Boulevard will be closed to thru traffic and detour signage will be installed to route traffic around the workzone. The contractor will also begin installing temporary water service to each property so the existing watermain can be replaced. Replacement of the sanitary sewer will begin shortly after the pavement has been removed.

CenterPoint Energy also anticipates to begin replacing the existing gas main along Stinson Blvd late next week.
