



St. Anthony Police Department Bank Robbery – Crime Alert



On October 25, 2019 at approximately 5:57pm, the St. Anthony Police Department responded to a report of a bank robbery that had just occurred at the Wells Fargo Bank, located at 2700 39th Avenue in St. Anthony. It was reported that a male suspect had entered the bank and handed the teller a note that demanded money. The teller pressed the emergency button and the suspect exited the bank without any cash. Officers from the St. Anthony Police Department, along with neighboring agencies set up a perimeter in the area and conducted a search, but the suspect was not located.

The St. Anthony Police Department, along with the Hennepin County Crime Lab, and the FBI continue to investigate.
