- Operates all types of equipment including but not limited to trucks up to 33,000 gross vehicle weight, tractors, backhoes, front-end loaders, skid loaders, snow plows, snow blowers, leaf blowers, trimmers, weed whips, and other pieces of equipment related parks maintenance, in a safe and proficient manner
- Performs a variety of skilled and unskilled functions such as carpentry, plumbing, masonry, and other duties as assigned
- Assesses situations and operation procedures to ensure that they Safety laws and regulations. Also recognizes potential hazards in the work environment and notifies the Public Works Superintendent and/or the Public Works Director if any corrective action is necessary
