



## 2016 Street and Utility Improvement Project



### Stinson Boulevard

#### Project Schedule Update

The week of April 11th, Stinson Blvd was closed between 37<sup>th</sup> Place and Silver Lane. Traffic control has been the project team's top priority. Additional signage and detours have been added as needed to control and reroute traffic. Crews are working to install temporary driveway access to local businesses and residences. The attached maps indicate the detour routes and temporary driveway accesses.

CenterPoint Energy will begin gas main and service replacement the week of April 18 starting at the intersection of Stinson Blvd and Silver Ln and continuing south .

The following is an anticipated schedule of upcoming construction activities:

#### April 18—April 22

- Pavement removal between 38th Ave and Silver Ln.
- Installation of temporary water.
- Begin replacing sanitary sewer, water main, and storm sewer at the intersection of Stinson Blvd and Silver Ln.

#### April 25—April 29

- Continue sanitary and storm sewer installation from Silver Ln to the south.

#### May 2—May 6

- Complete sanitary and storm sewer installation between Silver Ln and 3900 Stinson Blvd.
- Begin trunk storm sewer replacement from 3900 Stinson Blvd to the south.

The Stinson Blvd/Silver Ln intersection is anticipated to be closed to thru traffic through May 6. A traffic detour will be posted throughout the road closure rerouting traffic onto Silver Lake Rd and 37<sup>th</sup> Ave NE.

#### Bus Service

Metro Transit has been notified of the project schedule and has posted the temporary bus routes for the duration of the project at the existing bus stops along the project corridor.

The local school bus service and Metro Transit have been made aware of the anticipated closure at Sitnson Blvd and Silver Ln and accommodations are being made for students and commuters during this closure.

#### Changes to Construction Schedule

Please be aware the construction schedule may change throughout the project as a result of weather conditions or other activities beyond the contractor's control. Should a major change in the schedule be anticipated, we will do our best to communicate the change through this newsletter and through your field contact, Justin Moeller.


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
